

CONSTRUCTION OF A HAMMOCK



Each Yellow Leaf Hammock is 100% handwoven. To create a single hammock, a weaver can use more than 150,000 loops and 4 1/2 miles of yarn!

Our specially designed hammock weaves contour to your body and cradle you cozily, while always giving you plenty of room to stretch out.

Our hammock yarn is soft, vibrant, durable and weathersafe, so your hammock will always look and feel great!


- Take care when setting up your hammock and check the strength of your hanging structure and hardware regularly to avoid injury.
- Do not leave children unattended.
- Make sure your hammock is hung out of reach of puppies or pets that like to chew on interesting new "toys".
- Always handle by the eyes of the hammock to avoid tangling the scale lines.
- To avoid damage, hammockers must avoid wearing clothing and accessories that can catch on the yarn (buttons, exposed zippers, key chains, shoes with buckles, etc.).
- If you accidentally pull a loop out of place, repair it before further use. Spread the hammock and study the pulled loop. Trace the yarn that was pulled and gently tug on the surrounding weave to ease the yarn back into place.





ANATOMY OF A HAMMOCK

Brush up on your hammock vocabulary—here are the three parts of a hammock you need to know!



HOW TO CARE FOR YOUR HAMMOCK



Hand-wash in cold water with non-bleach detergent. Tie a string around the scale lines to prevent entanglement. Rinse thoroughly and hang to dry (spread open). Don't ever put hammocks in the dryer.

If you have squirrels or critters who might nibble your hammock, we highly recommend treating your hammock with a product called "bitter apple spray." It is a non-toxic tastedeterrent spray (often used to train puppies).

HOW TO STORE YOUR HAMMOCK

Your Yellow Leaf Hammock arrives packaged in a reusable "hammock tote"—make sure to keep your tote for travel and storage!

To pack your hammock back up, fold it in half, holding it by the eyes. Stuff the bed into the tote, followed by the scale lines. The eyes of the hammock should always go in last, at the top of the tote. Be sure to store your hammock somewhere safe + dry.



IDEAL HANGING DIMENSIONS

This diagram shows the optimal hanging dimensions for your hammock.



OPTIMAL HANGING DIMENSIONS

If your hammock environment doesn't match up to these measurements perfectly, don't worry!

You can hang it using our recommended ranges:

RANGE OF WIDTH 8 ft - 11 ft RANGE OF HEIGHT 4 ft - 6 ft

HOW TO GET IN YOUR HAMMOCK




Stand to one side of the hammock and spread it open, then sit down in the center.

Gently lay back on a diagonal and swing your legs in.

HOW TO HANG YOUR HAMMOCK




INSIDE YOUR HOME

Drill two hooks (or a "porch swing kit" from the hardware store) into a ceiling or wall beam. Use a rope or carabiner to link each hook with the eyes of the hammock.




BETWEEN TWO TREES

Wrap a rope or hammock strap securely around each tree trunk and attach the ropes to the eyes of the hammock using a knot or carabiner.




FROM AN OVERHEAD BEAM

By wrapping two ropes securely around the beams or posts and attaching the ropes to the eyes of the hammock (using a knot or carabiner).



A HYBRID APPROACH

You can also use a combination of structures to hang a hammock—for instance, a porch post and a tree. Secure a rope to the porch by drilling a hook or wrapping it around. Secure the other rope to the tree. Make sure the two sides are hung evenly!



HAMMOCK STAND COMPATIBLE

Our hammocks are compatible with most hammock stands on the market—if you are considering a hammock stand, double check our product measurements with the stand manufacturer's recommendations.
